Promoting Positive Behavior

Goal - Promote positive <u>school-wide</u> behavior so that each student will graduate prepared to succeed beyond high school



0	Establish effective relationships with all students, getting to know their learning needs-academic background, life experiences, language, and culture						
0	Post, teach, and revisit behavior expectations in a positive way						
	Present-Do the right thing, in the right place, at the right time.						
	Respectful-Listen, learn, seek to understand, and allow others to do the same. Follow directions the first time. Honor others. Take care of your surroundings.						
	Integrity – Doing the right thing when no one is watching.						
	Determined-Don't give up on your work or in what is right. Persevere!						
	Engage- make a difference, have a voice, try new things.						
0	Administrators will consistently and positively greet students in the hallways and teachers will consistently and positively greet all students at the doorway as they come into class (of course there will be days and times when a teacher cannot do this)						
0	Compliment and recognize positive behaviors. For example, "thanks for being here." "Thanks for being on time." "You are taking greater ownership of your work."						
0	Use School wide behavior plan to help change student behavior

*"A student who creates a disruption of the educational process... may be excluded by the staff member from the classroom or activity area...for all or any portion of the balance of the school day, or until the principal/supervisor and staff member have met and discussed interventions implemented consistent with the school wide discipline plan, whichever occurs first."

"The staff member may request a meeting be promptly held among the staff member, principal or supervisor, and the parent(s)/ guardian(s). Staff faced with a disruptive student have the right to establish an enforceable behavior plan for the student with the principal and parent/ guardian."
